Minutes of the Annual General Meeting held at 19.30 on 17th June 2026

The AGM for the year 2025/2026 was held online by Zoom.

On 17th June 2026, Maidenhead Neighbourhood Forum had 76 full members who were eligible to attend the meeting. Of those 11 attended the AGM virtually (and a further 20 gave a proxy vote to the chair or else voted in advance).

AGM

4. To dissolve Maidenhead Neighbourhood Forum, according to paragraph 12.2 of the Constitution

Each of the items 1-3 (above) was made available in advance of the AGM and presented to the meeting by the co-Chairs with an opportunity for participants to make comments or ask questions prior to voting taking place.

Resolution 3. Seconded by Donna Stimson. Approved by all 11 members present and 15 proxy votes.

Resolution 4. Dissolution of MNF was seconded by Nicola Stingelin, approved by all 11 members present and 20 proxy votes. Total votes 31 (nb 26 were required for quorum). Motion passed, MNF will now dissolve with immediate effect.
